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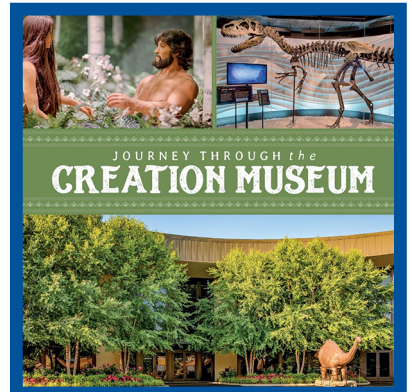
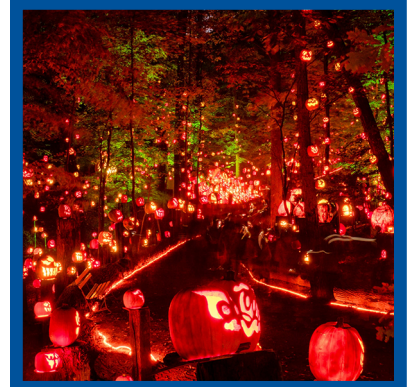
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ITINERARY

Day One: Departure will be at 7:00 a.m. from our Main Office in Pulaski, Tennessee. On the way up to Louisville, we will make a stop at Chaney's Dairy Barn- an operation started in the 1940's- for a farm tour, lunch, and ice cream. Our first Louisville stop will be at the Mega Caverns where we'll take a historic tram tour of the 100-acre property! It is classified as the largest building in the state of Kentucky and holds endless stories of how its purpose has changed over time. After that we'll check in to our hotel and have a little down time and a few snacks. The perfect ending to our day is the VIP experience at the Jack O'Lantern Spectacular in Iroquois Park! It is truly magical to see over 5,000 artistically carved pumpkins displayed along the wooded path.

Day Two: Breakfast is at the hotel this morning. The majority of our day will be spent at the Ark Encounter in Williamstown. Ark Encounter features a full-size Noah's Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Spanning 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high, this modern engineering marvel amazes visitors young and old. Dinner tonight will be a buffet at Derby Dinner Playhouse. The show, "Dial M for Murder" ,is performed in the round and will keep you on the edge of your seat!

Day Three: Our last day kicks off at the Kentucky Derby Museum. We will experience the backside of the racetrack during a rail-side breakfast in the Track Kitchen all while watching the horses during their morning workouts. The rest of the day will be spent at the fascinating Creation Museum. The state-of-the-art, 75,000-square-foot Creation Museum brings the pages of the Bible to life, casting its characters and animals in dynamic form and placing them in familiar settings. One last stop before heading home, the National Corvette Museum! Our group will experience the special ambience of having the Museum to ourselves, combined with a meet-and-greet by Museum staff, a VIP Museum Tour, an elegant four-course dinner, live music and dancing, as well as a parting gift! We should arrive back in Pulaski by 11:30 p.m.
